



Updated COVID19 Response May 20, 2020

In accordance with Phase One set forth by Proclamation Number 59JBE2020 by Governor John Bel Edwards and the Order of the Supreme Court of the State of Louisiana, the City Court reopened on May 18, 2020, for limited services.

Court Activities

The public will be allowed to pay fines & fees in person, handle outstanding bench warrants, obtain extensions, and reschedule court dates. The public will be also be allowed to file civil pleadings in person.

All cases (civil, criminal, traffic and juvenile) that were scheduled between March 17, 2020, and June 4, 2020, will be reset with notifications provided at the last known address of the parties.

Due to the ongoing threat of COVID19 a limited number of persons will be allowed in the courthouse. As a result, we continue to encourage the public to visit the City Court's website to pay fines & fees online at www.citycourt.org or by telephone at (985) 542-3455; and, to utilize fax filing for civil cases. Staff and Public Safety

All persons entering the courthouse will be required to wear a mask and submit to an infrared thermometer check. While in the Courthouse, strict adherence to the court's social distancing guidelines will be required. Only the individual with court business will be allowed inside the courthouse, unless that individual is being accompanied by a care giver or an interpreter.
